School Campus Turns Urban Oasis.

A New Learning Experience: ‘Classroom Without Walls’

Opening Ceremony of Po Leung Kuk Stanley Ho Sau Nan Primary School and Dedication Ceremony of Facilities

Traditional school campus has always been deemed boring and stereotypical. Commissioned this academic year, Po Leung Kuk Ho Sau Nan Primary School’s new campus was very different from the traditional school campus, combining the style of Suzhou gardens with features of both Chinese and Western architectural cultures. Ample green areas and flowerbeds were added to the campus, where wooden screens were used to create a natural landscape, turning the campus into an urban oasis, providing a comfortable learning environment for students.

The new campus received the HKIA Merit Award of Hong Kong – Community Building, with a design utterly different from the traditional eight-storey campus with a ground floor ball court. The campus adopted a low-rise building design of four storeys, and, locating on the first floor, the ball court created a centre of focus amidst the cluster of campus buildings. Classrooms, assembly hall, library and special rooms were located in three buildings that surrounded the ball court, where different functional spaces were connected three-dimensionally through corridors, gardens, stairs and link bridges.

Adopting the ‘classroom without walls’ concept, the School fully utilized campus space for learning activities to attract students to take initiative to learn. Taking the spaces outside library and visual arts room as an example, they extended learning space, enabling students to learn beyond classrooms.

Po Leung Kuk Ho Sau Nan Primary Schools held the New Campus Opening Ceremony and Dedication Ceremony of Facilities today, with the honour of having Mr Peh Yun Lu, Simon, SBS, IDSM, Commissioner, ICAC and Mr Yeung Yun Hung, Kevin, JP, Under Secretary for Education as the officiating guests.

Dr Eleanor Kwok, Chairman of Po Leung Kuk thanked the donors, Education Bureau and the team of architects at Architectural Services Department for giving Ho Sau Nan Primary School an innovative and unique new campus in her speech. She also commended the campus as being technological well-equipped, as wireless network covered most of the campus, which could help with STEM education and assist various innovative technological activities.
